Kenya will host the 8th annual African Growth and Opportunity Act (Agoa) meeting this year, the Trade Minister has said.

Mr Amos Kimunya said the country has been chosen to host the economic forum to review the impact of the scheme as well as chart forward new ways on how to take advantage of the existing opportunities created by the Act.

He said the Agoa meeting will help the country to discuss and strengthen information exchange links between different countries. Grow business

The minister spoke during the official opening of parliamentary departmental committees on Finance, Trade and Planning and Agriculture, Land and Natural Resources workshop at Sarova Whitesands hotel in Mombasa.

"Kenya will have an opportunity this year to grow in business by interacting with Agoa members; we shall both, government and private stakeholders, have information about new business ventures abroad," said Mr Kimunya.

The Forum will be held at The Kicc Nairobi from the 4th to 6th August 2009 and will host a number of delegations from various African countries and the United States of America.

Along side the forum, there will be a Trade fair organised and run by the private sector to show case Kenya's and Africa's trade products at large.
